CLINICAL STAGE

LOCAL TREATMENT

Stage IE - II

- Clinical Trial or
- Locoregional Radiotherapy with or without Rituxan
- Surgery for certain sites (lung, breast [with or without Radiotherapy], skin^c, thyroid, colon/small bowel)

Stage III - IV
low grade

- Clinical Trial
- Treat as indolent lymphoma
- Possible options: Rituximab, FND/Rituximab or FCR^d

Stage IE - IV,
MALT^a lymphomas
coexistent with large cell
lymphoma^b

Treat per Diffuse Large B-Cell
Lymphoma Guidelines (Page 1)

Sites of common involvement:
parotid, skin, breast, GI tract,
thyroid, ocular adnexae, and lung

^aMALT = mucosal - associated lymphoid tissue.

^bDLBCL coexistent with MALT cell lymphoma is managed as DLBCL.

^cBarelia serology check when appropriate.

^dFCR - Fludarabine, Cyclophosphamide, Rituximab
